GENERAL COMPETITION ELIGIBILITY, RULES & REQUIREMENTS (8.20.2025)

Events: To maintain the timing of an event, event offerings and entries may be limited. Registration will close when the competition is full or by the entry deadline indicated, whichever comes first. Please see the event worksheet for specific details. Unless otherwise indicated, the only Solo Spotlight category being offered is Light Entertainment. Ensembles will be divided by age and into Low, Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum categories following the same level guidelines as other events with these divisions.

Rules: Events will be run in accordance with the latest ISI rule book and as posted on www.skateisi.org. Overall team scores will be calculated according to the handbook. All coaches, judges, and participants should be familiar with ISI requirements.

Eligibility: Competition events are open to current ISI members only. Coaches who wish to enter skaters in this competition must be current ISI Professional members in good standing. All competitors must compete at their highest test level passed, and all tests must be registered with the ISI National Office in accordance with their guidelines. Competitors must represent a current ISI Administrative Member (rink or club).

Members of other organizations are eligible and welcome to compete in ISI competitions as long as they are members of ISI and have the appropriate ISI tests passed and registered with the ISI National office. (USFS members should refer to the ISI/USFS Joint Statement of Policy in the ISI and/ or USFS rule books. See below for the minimum ISI test level in which USFS skaters must compete.

Skaters are expected to compete at their true ability level and to uphold high ethical standards. Refer to ISI handbook for more information. USFS Moves in the Field test levels have no bearing on any ISI test levels. USFS adult skaters, age 21 and over, may petition the competition director for permission to compete lower than levels listed. Gender should be entered as assigned at birth. Freestyle, Open Freestyle and Solo Compulsory events are separated by male / female. For accommodation, please contact the Competition Organizers.

Verification: All skaters' test levels and memberships will be verified with the ISI office prior to this competition. Coach memberships will be verified with ISI to receive a credential and be allowed to put skaters on the ice. Judge's certification levels will be verified for coaches to judge.

Entries & Entry Fees: Entries and event offerings may be limited to maintain the timing of the event. Registration will close when competition is full or the listed entry deadline, whichever comes first. Participants entering this event do so at their own risk - refunds will not be given. Worksheets are included in this packet to assist the registration process but are not entry forms and will not be accepted as such.

Team Entries: Skating Directors, Coaches or Team Captains should register teams. Full roster and payment can be put through Entry Eeze. Follow up entry with an Excel or Google Sheets document listing information asked for in the worksheet and send to email address indicated.

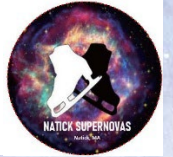
Solo Compulsories: This competition will use the same assigned elements as the ISI National Events of the same year. See link below. Skaters Tots to FS 4 will be on Half Ice. FS 5 and up, Full Ice. <https://www.skateisi.org/competition/competition-information/national-event-descriptions/>

Events With Props: Most arenas have limited space to build or hold props off ice. Please plan accordingly. For rules / guidelines related to props, refer to the ISI Handbook.

Awards: All competitors will receive an award. Scoring and points awarded will follow the current ISI handbook. Awards will be presented onsite. Each competitor earns points towards their teams Overall score. Overall team scores will be calculated according to the handbook and posted after the event has concluded.

Music & Media: Entry Eeze will be used to recruit digital music uploads for competitors. **Deadline to submit music is indicated in the event worksheet.** The lead to any music cannot be longer than 12 seconds. Skaters should bring a CD to the arena for backup. Photographs and video tapes may be taken for personal use only. They may not be sold, rented or otherwise used for any commercial or profit-making business unless authorized in writing by the Competition Director. This competition's hosting facility/organization, ISI and/or District 1 may use such photographs for any lawful purpose, including for example, such purposes as publicity, illustration, advertising, and web content.

Coach Credentials: Coaches who wish to be onsite during the competition must have a credential. Requirements and directions to request a credential will be released in the competition's guidelines accompanying skater times and schedules. Volunteer or Judging hours may be required. In the event that judges are required, ISI / District 1 requires each team to send one judge for the first event and a second every 10 events entered.
